



EPS Grading Policy 2020-2021

As a result of COVID-19 school closures during the 2020-2021 school year, Extera Public Schools has adjusted the grading policy to reflect academic achievement and effort that is measurable during this unprecedented academic year. A committee of teachers, resource specialists, and school leaders agreed upon the following policy. This will take effect the week of October 12, 2020.

Grading Agreements

- Teachers will provide Overall Academic Grades in the following subjects:
 - English Language Arts: Reading, Writing, Language, Speaking & Listening
 - Mathematics
 - Science
 - Social Science
- Teachers will provide Effort Grades in the following areas:
 - Visual & Performing Arts
 - Physical Education
 - Trailblazer Traits
- Teachers will provide short comments on student performance for each of the following subjects:
 - English Language Arts
 - Mathematics
 - Science
 - Social Science
 - Trailblazer Traits (optional)
- Teachers will provide summarized ELD grades for EL students using the following headings:
 - Listening
 - Speaking
 - Reading
 - Writing
- Grade level teams will determine categories of work and percentage weights with School Director approval based on the criteria below:
 - Participation Grades will be based on: voice, chat, asynchronous work, small group work with teacher/ST, group projects, office hours attendance, small group attendance, etc.
 - Classwork Grades will be based on daily Google Classroom, Seesaw, other learning websites, and online platform assignments, exit tickets, projects, presentations, group work, etc.
 - Assessments/Summative Projects Grades will be based on: Tests that assess mastery or understanding of classwork, group or individual projects, accumulation of assignments, etc.
 - Quizzes will be based on a check for understanding of content taught on a short-term basis, etc.
- Teachers input grades on Infinite Campus where you can track a student's progress weekly. Students will be allowed to make up missed assignments for the week by that Sunday night with 11:59pm as the cutoff time. We recommend students turn the assignment in as early as possible.
 - Teachers will mark assignments as turned in by the following Monday.
 - Grades will be posted for completed assignment/assessment/project a week after they are turned in
- Teachers, parents/guardians, and students can request a student retake a failed assessment and will have a week to complete the assessment after receiving it for partial credit.
 - Teachers will have a week after the assessment is retaken to post the new grade.

Excellent	Participation: Student participates synchronously/asynchronously 90-100% of the time. Work Completion: Student completes 90-100% of the work assigned on time. Self-Advocacy: Student always makes an effort to ask for missed work, makes up assignments, and asks for help/clarification when needed.	4
Satisfactory	Participation: Student participates synchronously/asynchronously 80-89% of the time. Work Completion: Student completes 80-89% of the work assigned. Self-Advocacy: Student regularly checks in on assignments and asks for help/clarification when needed.	3
Needs Improvement	Participation: Student participates synchronously/asynchronously 70-79% of the time. Work Completion: Student completes 70-79% of the work assigned. Self-Advocacy: Student sometimes asks for help/clarification when needed.	2
